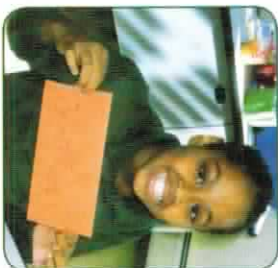

Incoming third, fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh grade students are selected through a lottery, in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act. All applicants not immediately selected will be added to a waiting list.



## Eligibility, Application & Deadline

- Applications must be received by midnight on April 1st to be included in the lottery
- All children residing in New York State are eligible to attend Lavelle Prep
- Preferences will be given to siblings of current Lavelle Prep students
- Preferences will be given for students residing in CSD 31 (Staten Island)
- To qualify for Special Education lottery, student must have current Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
- A separate application must be completed for each child
- Parents/guardians will be notified of acceptance at the lottery on drawing, and posted on our website by May 1st 2017

- Applicants not immediately selected will be added to a waiting list
